On 6th day of March, 2020, a citable settlement agreement was entered into and between Screen Actors Guild-American Federation of Television and Radio Artists ("SAG-AFTRA") and Home Box Office, Inc. and Thespians of the Falls Productions Services, LLC (collectively "Producer") with regard to SAG-AFTRA's Statement of Claim and Demand for Arbitration. Case No. TM 13310, seeking full compensation for stunt performers who rendered services on more than one episode (or "Picture" as referenced in the SAG-AFTRA Television Agreement) of the series I Know This Much Is True in a day.

Producer expressly agrees, from today and going forward, to engage and pay stunt performers under a daily or weekly contract for each episode on which the stunt performer renders services, or engage the stunt performer under a weekly multi-picture contract and pay the Multiple Picture, Weekly Contract rate, where the stunt performer agrees to accept the contract.

Home Box Office, Inc.'s agreement to the aforementioned practice will be subject to change in the event that the applicable contract language in the SAG-AFTRA Basic Agreement and/or SAG-AFTRA Television Agreement materially changes as a result of bargaining negotiations.
