PENALTIES, ALLOWANCES, & ADJUSTMENTS					
Overtime	Agent may commission overtime if overtime is based on overscale original employment. Otherwise, an agent may not commission overtime that would lower a performer's compensation below scale payment listed in the appropriate Collective Bargaining Agreement.				
Late Payment, Rest Period Violation (Forced Call), Meal Period Violation, Prop & Wardrobe Allowance, Per Diems & Reimbursements, Relocation Allowance, Mileage	Agent may not commission if the penalty is based on the Union negotiated rate in the CBA.				
Premium Pay – nights or holidays, Wet or Smoke Pay Adjustments	Agent may commission as long as original employment is overscale.				
Vacation	An agent cannot commission vacation pay if it lowers the performer's compensation below the scale payment in the applicable Collective Bargaining Agreement. <u>EXCEPTION</u> : An agent may commission vacation pay if it is calculated based on over scale original compensation ( <i>i.e.</i> original employment is paid over scale).				

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> All References to overscale in this document generally refer to SCALE PLUS 10% (or in instances where an agent negotiates in excess of scale)

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> If initial compensation is freely negotiable and is negotiated above applicable State minimum wage rates, it is commissionable provided that such compensation above minimum wage may not not be put towards compensation that would be due for other services or uses, e.g. overtime, penalties, fees, promotional appearances, merchandising, or re-use

<sup>\*</sup>Overscale initial compensation does not equal overscale residuals. These guidelines are based on the assumption that the agent has not negotiated residuals terms greater than CBA terms. Agents may commission (a) any overscale *residual* payment they have negotiated above SAG-AFTRA minimums (b) any residual payment based on over scale original employment payment. Applies only to reuse of a program as a whole, and not to the use of an excerpt of one program in another program.
