PENALTIES, ALLOWANCES, & ADJUSTMENTS				
Overtime	Agent may commission overtime if overtime is based on over scale original employment. Otherwise, an agent may not commission overtime that would lower a performer's compensation below the scale payment listed in the appropriate Collective Bargaining Agreement.			
Late Payment, Rest Period Violation (Forced Call), Meal Period Violation, Prop & Wardrobe Allowance, Per Diems & Reimbursements, Relocation Allowance, Mileage	Agent may not commission if the penalty is based on the Union negotiated rate in the CBA.			
Premium Pay – nights or holidays, Wet or Smoke Pay Adjustments	Agent may commission as long as original employment is overscale.			
Vacation	An agent cannot commission vacation pay if it lowers the performer's compensation below the scale payment in the applicable Collective Bargaining Agreement. EXCEPTION: An agent may commission vacation pay if it is calculated based on over scale original compensation (i.e. original employment is paid over scale).			

¹ If initial compensation is freely negotiable, and is negotiated above applicable State minimum wage rates, it is commissionable.
