## CALLING ALL CANDIDATES

### MIAMI LOCAL ELECTIONS

This year, the SAG-AFTRA Miami Local will hold elections for the following Local Officer, Local Board and Convention Delegate positions:

President	2-year term
Vice President	2-year term
Secretary	2-year term
Four (4) Local Board Members - South Florida*	2-year term
Two (2) Local Board Members - Central Florida*	2-year term
One (1) Local Board Member - Alabama*	2-year term
One (1) Local Board Member - Puerto Rico*	2-year term
Four (4) Local Board Members-at-Large	2-year term
Four (4) Alternate Local Board Members-at-Large	2-year term
Thirteen (13) Convention Delegates	2-year term

*\*To be eligible to run for or serve as a Local Board Member representing South Florida, Central Florida, Alabama or Puerto Rico, a member must reside within the applicable geographic area as defined in the Miami Local Constitution.*

Those members elected as President, Vice President, Secretary, Local Board Members and Convention Delegates, by virtue of their election to those positions, also will be elected as Alternate National Board Members who may be called upon to serve at National Board Meetings when the National Board member from Miami is unable to attend. The President, by virtue of their election to that position, also serves as a Convention Delegate.

Members may run by petition for any of these positions. Nominating petitions and election materials will be made available online in the member section of the SAG-AFTRA website beginning on Wednesday, May 21, 2025 at [www.sagaftra.org/elections](http://www.sagaftra.org/elections) or they may be obtained offline by a request in writing via email to [mamielections@sagaftra.org](mailto:mamielections@sagaftra.org). Petitions must be signed by no fewer than ten (10) Miami Local members in good standing and received electronically through the online nominating portal **or** offline via email to [mamielections@sagaftra.org](mailto:mamielections@sagaftra.org) no later than Friday, June 20, 2025 at 5 P.M. (EDT). Additional requirements for the submission of nominating materials will be described online and offline in the SAG-AFTRA nominating petition instruction kit.

Once the nominating period has closed on June 20, a candidate may not revoke their consent to serve.

### 2025 MIAMI ELECTION CALENDAR (all times EDT)

#### May 21

Nominating petitions available.

#### June 16

Cut-off for eligibility to vote in the local election.

Local members must be paid-up and in good standing for the November 2024 and/or May 2025 dues periods on or before June 16 to be eligible to vote\*.

#### June 20, 5:00 P.M.

Deadline for submission of petitions and any other required materials.

#### July 16

Ballots mailed\*

*\*If candidates run unopposed, they will be declared elected and ballots will not be required.*

#### August 15, 10:00 A.M.

Deadline for receipt of voted ballot.

#### October 25-28

Convention

### SUMMARY OF ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

All candidates must meet the eligibility requirements established by Article VIII of the SAG-AFTRA Constitution, Article II.C of the Nominations & Elections Policy, and the Miami Local Constitution which include the following:

#### Local Officer or Local Board Member

- Must be at least 18 years old upon taking office and be a member in good standing of the local for twelve (12) months.
- Must be paid-up from the beginning of the November 2024 and May 2025 dues periods as reflected in the schedule below\*.
- For regional Local Board member positions only, must live within the applicable geographical area as defined in the Miami Local Constitution.

#### Convention Delegates

- Must be at least 18 years old upon taking office and a member in good standing of the local for six (6) months.
- Must be paid-up from the beginning of the May 2025 dues period as reflected in the schedule below\*.

\*Where applicable, members must be in compliance with the Interactive Media Agreement Dues Relief Payment Program to be eligible to vote, or run for office. Request for the May 2025 Interactive Media Agreement Dues Relief Program and 1st installment payment must have been received on or before 6/9/25 (or date of nomination, whichever comes first).
