CALLING ALL CANDIDATES

SAN DIEGO LOCAL ELECTIONS

This year, the SAG-AFTRA San Diego Local will hold elections for the following Local Officer, Local Board and Convention Delegate positions:

President	2-year term
Vice President	2-year term
Secretary	2-year term
Five (5) Local Board Members	2-year term
Six (6) Convention Delegates	2-year term

Those members elected as President, Vice President, Secretary, Local Board Members and Convention Delegates, by virtue of their election to those positions, also will be elected as Alternate National Board Members who may be called upon to serve at National Board Meetings when the National Board member from San Diego is unable to attend. The President, by virtue of their election to those positions, also serve as Convention Delegates.

Nominations will be accepted both at the San Diego Local Membership Meeting at 6:30 P.M. (PDT), Tuesday, June 17, 2025 at IBEW Local Union 569 located at 4545 Viewridge Ave. STE 100, San Diego, CA 92123 and by petition.

At the membership meeting, nominations will be accepted from the floor and members may nominate themselves. A written statement signed by the person nominated must be submitted no later than July 11, 5:00 P.M. (PDT) stating that they accept the nomination and consent to serve in the office for which they are nominated and will not withdraw as a candidate after the nomination period has closed.

Members may also run by petition for any of these positions. Nominating petitions and election materials will be made available online in the member section of the SAG-AFTRA website beginning on Wednesday, June 11, 2025 at [www.sagaftra.org/elections](http://www.sagaftra.org/elections) or they may be obtained offline by a request in writing via email to [sandiegoelections@sagaftra.org](mailto:sandiegoelections@sagaftra.org). Petitions must be signed by no fewer than fifteen (15) San Diego Local members in good standing and received electronically through the online nominating portal **or** offline via email to [sandiegoelections@sagaftra.org](mailto:sandiegoelections@sagaftra.org) **no later than Friday, July 11, 2025 at 5 P.M. (PDT)**. Additional requirements for the submission of nominating materials will be described online and offline in the SAG-AFTRA nominating petition instruction kit.

Once the nominating period has closed on July 11, a candidate may not revoke their consent to serve.

SUMMARY OF ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

All candidates must meet the eligibility requirements established by Article VIII of the SAG-AFTRA Constitution, Article II.C of the Nominations & Elections Policy, and the San Diego Local Constitution which include the following:

Local Officer or Local Board Member

- Must be at least 18 years old upon taking office and be a member in good standing of the local for twelve (12) months.
- Must be paid-up from the beginning of the November 2024 and May 2025 dues as reflected in the schedule below\*.

Convention Delegates

- Must be at least 18 years old upon taking office and a member in good standing of the local for six (6) months.
- Must be paid-up from the beginning of the May 2025 dues as reflected in the schedule below\*.

\*Where applicable, members must be in compliance with the Interactive Media Agreement Dues Relief Payment Program to be eligible to vote, or run for office. Request for the May 2025 Interactive Media Agreement Dues Relief Program and 1st installment payment must have been received on or before 6/9/25 (or date of nomination, whichever comes first).
