CALLING ALL CANDIDATES

SEATTLE LOCAL ELECTIONS

This year, the SAG-AFTRA Seattle Local will hold elections for the following Local Officer, Local Board and Convention Delegate positions:

President	2-year term
Vice President – Actor/Performer*	2-year term
Vice President – Broadcast	2-year term
Secretary	2-year term
Nine (9) Local Board Members at Large	2-year term
One (1) Local Board Member – Alaska**	2-year term
One (1) Local Board Member – Idaho***	2-year term
One (1) Local Board Member – Montana****	2-year term
Six (6) Convention Delegates	2-year term

*The Actor/Performer Vice President category includes all work categories other than Broadcast, e.g. Actor/Performer, Recording Artist, Singer, Dancer and Stunt Performer.

**Local Board Member (Alaska) shall reside in Alaska.

***Local Board Member (Idaho) shall reside in Idaho.

****Local Board Member (Montana) shall reside in Montana.

Those members elected as President, Vice Presidents, Secretary, Local Board Members and Convention Delegates, by virtue of their election to those positions, also will be elected as Alternate National Board Members who may be called upon to serve at National Board Meetings when the National Board member from Seattle is unable to attend. The President, by virtue of their election to that position, also serves as a Convention Delegate.

Members may run by petition for any of these positions. Nominating petitions and election materials will be made available online in the member section of the SAG-AFTRA website beginning on Wednesday, May 28, 2025 at www.sagaftra.org/elections or they may be obtained offline by a request in writing via email to seattleelections@sagaftra.org. Petitions must be signed by no fewer than six (6) Seattle Local members in good standing and received electronically through the online nominating portal **or** offline via email to seattleelections@sagaftra.org no later than Friday, June 27, 2025 at 5 P.M. (PDT). Additional requirements for the submission of nominating materials will be described online and offline in the SAG-AFTRA nominating petition instruction kit.

Once the nominating period has closed on June 27, a candidate may not revoke their consent to serve.

Deadline for submission of petitions and any other required materials.

Cut-off for eligibility to nominate and vote in the local election.

Local members must be paid-up and in good standing for the May 2025 dues period on or before July 7 to be eligible to vote*.

August 4

Ballots mailed*

*If candidates run unopposed, they will be declared elected and ballots will not be required.

September 3, 9:30 A.M.

Deadline for receipt of voted ballot.

October 25-28

SUMMARY OF ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

All candidates must meet the eligibility requirements established by Article VIII of the SAG-AFTRA Constitution, Article II.C of the Nominations & Elections Policy, and the Seattle Local Constitution which include the following:

Local Officer or Local Board Member

- Must be at least 18 years old upon taking office and be a member in good standing of the local for twelve (12) months.
- Must be paid-up from the beginning of the November 2024 and May 2025 dues periods as reflected in the schedule below*.
- For member category positions only, must be a member of that category for twelve (12) months.
- For regional Local Board member positions only, must live within the applicable state.

Convention Delegates

- Must be at least 18 years old upon taking office and a member in good standing of the local for six (6) months.
- Must be paid-up from the beginning of the May 2025 dues period as reflected in the schedule below*.

*Where applicable, members must be in compliance with the Interactive Media Agreement Dues Relief Payment Program to be eligible to vote, or run for office. Request for the May 2025 Interactive Media Agreement Dues Relief Program and 1st installment payment must have been received on or before 6/9/25 (or date of nomination, whichever comes first).
