Until we get a fair deal, ALL of our members should stand strong and follow some important guidance to maximize our leverage during the strike.

Familiarize yourself with work you CAN and CANNOT do during a TV/Theatrical/Streaming strike. Visit sagaftstrike.org for details.

For struck work, instruct your representatives to discontinue negotiations with the studios, streamers and networks.

SAG-AFTRA MEMBERSHIP RULE 1A READS:

No member shall render any services, or make an agreement to perform services, for any employer against whom the union is conducting a strike, nor shall any member otherwise violate any strike order of the union.

Currently, we do not have an agreement with the AMPTP, which means members cannot work or perform services related to the TV/Theatrical Contracts.

Any member who disregards the strike order could face discipline, per the SAG-AFTRA Constitution and SAG-AFTRA Membership Rules.

Pre-members and those performers who wish to join our union in the future need to remember one very important rule: Any non-member seeking future membership in SAG-AFTRA **will not** be permitted to join if they performed covered services for a struck company during the strike.

BY STANDING TOGETHER DURING THE STRIKE, WE WILL GET A FAIR CONTRACT.
